## GENERAL SHOW RULES:

- Entries are open to any bona fide 4H, FFA, Grange, Independent or Junior Breed Association member.
- Exhibitors must not have passed their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday (for showing steers) or their 21<sup>st</sup> birthday (for showing heifers) as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Showmanship will be based on the age of the exhibitor as of January 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Entries must be submitted online through the website [www.sisqfair.com](http://www.sisqfair.com) until 5:00 PM on Thursday, May 9th (see instructions). Late entries submitted on site Friday before 9:00 PM will be charged an additional \$20.00 fee and must be paid in cash (does not apply to Pee Wee & Mothers Day Showmanship Classes).
- There will be no limit on the number of entries for an exhibitor. An exhibitor with multiple animals in one class must have another junior exhibitor show the animal(s).
- Steer Entries: All steers will be weighed and entered into appropriate weight classes. Exhibitors entered in the English Steer division (Hereford, Angus, Shorthorn) will be breed certified by show management, a copy of transfer papers, or an affidavit of transferee of registration papers from their National Breed Association in the exhibitors name as of the show date. Steers without certification must be shown in the Black/Black X or All Other Color division.
- Heifer Entries: All heifers will be entered into the appropriate classes by their date of birth. Exhibitors must have registration papers, a copy of transfer papers or an affidavit of transferee of registration papers from their National Breed Association in the exhibitors name as of the show date. The Commercial Heifer division is for all unregistered heifers.

- Showmanship finals will be at the conclusion of the show. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners of Senior, Intermediate and Junior Showmanship will compete for the Overall Beef Showman award. Exhibitor and animal must be entered in a Jackpot class together to be eligible for showmanship.
- Barns will open to exhibitors' on Friday at 1:00 PM. The scales will be available from 1:00 to 9:00 PM after exhibitor has checked in at the livestock office.
- There will be no fitting chutes/exhibitor stations allowed to be set up between the Avenue of Champion pens and the show ring.
- Bedding will not be provided and no straw will be allowed. Wood chips or shavings only to be used. There will be shavings available for sale on site during the show.
- All animals must be washed at designated wash racks only.
- Steer Entries: MUST BE on the grounds, checked in and weighed by 9:00 PM Friday, May 10th.
- Heifer Entries: MUST BE checked in NO later than 9:00 AM, Saturday, May 11th. **Exhibitors not arriving until Saturday must call the office by 12:00 PM on Friday with exhibitors name and animal(s) birth date.**
- All California health inspections and brand inspections laws are to be followed by the exhibitor.
- All individuals showing must be clean and neatly attired. Shirts with collars, long pants and closed toe shoes are MANDATORY. No uniforms, hats, t-shirts or scoop-neck blouses are allowed.
- Each exhibitor participating in showmanship must show his or her own animal, excluding pee-wee showmanship exhibitors.
- Any exhibitor or adult chaperone found in violation of show rules will be required by show management to load livestock and leave the grounds immediately, forfeiting all premiums and/or awards won. Any premiums or awards won are kept by the 10<sup>th</sup> DAA and not awarded. All payments must be settled and pens/areas cleaned prior to leaving the grounds.
- Show management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes for the benefit of the show. And/or remove any exhibitor or spectator for any conduct in which they feel reflects poorly on the event.
- Exhibitors will be allowed to leave at the conclusion of the show once all payments have been settled and pens/areas have been clean and inspected by show management.
- Class premiums will be paid to 4<sup>th</sup> place, awarding 1<sup>st</sup> 40%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 25%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20% and 4<sup>th</sup> 15% of the 50% pay out from exhibitors showing in this class (with the exception of the fitting contest). No premiums are paid for break winners, overall class only.
- All premiums will be mailed by the Friday after the Jackpot show to the address on the entry form.

#### GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING RULES:

- There will be no food, alcohol or open beverage containers without lids allowed in the livestock barns.
- There will be no smoking allowed in the livestock barns or around the show ring.
- No dogs are allowed on the grounds.
- All vehicle lanes must be accessible at all times during the event. Do not block any roads or alley ways between the barns. This is for safety and maintenance issues.
- There will be a food and drink concessionaire onsite throughout the event.
- Please be courteous to your fellow exhibitors, we are all here to learn and have a good time.

#### ADDITIONAL FEES:

- Pens are limited and will be \$30 each. Exhibitor must reserve by calling the fair office and making payment by Visa or MasterCard. Pens will be assigned by show management and priority given to exhibitors that have traveled the farthest. There is no charge to use the tie outs or beef barn.
- Camping is available with water and electricity hookups for \$20.00 per night. A dump station is on site. There will be NO camping in the barns.

- Any pens, tie out areas, tack areas and camp space not properly cleaned before leaving, show management has the right to deduct \$20.00 per area from the appropriate exhibitors premium check.

**FITTING CONTEST:**

- Contest will be held at approximately 6:00 PM on Friday, May 10th.
- Teams will be made up of two (2) people. It is recommended that all team members be registered in the Jackpot Show on Saturday to participate but not mandatory.
- Each team will supply an animal to be fit and groomed.
- Each team will have 1 ½ hours to fit their animal and are required to supply their own fitting and grooming supplies.
- Depending on the number of teams, show management may break the teams into Novice, Junior and/or Advance divisions.
- Class premiums will be paid to 3<sup>rd</sup> place, awarding 1<sup>st</sup> 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 30% and 3<sup>rd</sup> 20% of the 50% pay out from exhibitors showing in this contest. Sullivan’s Supply provides awards to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams in each division.

**CLASSES & INSTRUCTIONS TO ENTER:**

- Go to the Siskiyou Golden Fairgrounds website [www.sisqgfair.com](http://www.sisqgfair.com). Click on Interim Events and then the Jackpot Livestock Show.
- Click on the “Enter Online” button.
- Create an account in the Blue Ribbon program (an account needs to be set up for each exhibitor).
- Be sure to include the date of birth of exhibitor and ALL animals entered.
- Select the classes to be entered (Division – Lot):
  - 400-1 Fitting Contest (per participant) \$25.00
  - 500-1 Steer-English (Purebred Angus, Hereford & Shorthorn) \$40.00
  - 500-2 Steer-Black/BlackX \$40.00
  - 500-3 Steer-All Other Colors (less than 50% Black) \$40.00

- 501-1 Registered Heifer-Angus \$40.00
- 501-2 Registered Heifer-Hereford \$40.00
- 501-3 Registered Heifer-All Other Breeds \$40.00
  
- 502-1 Commercial Heifer-British (Angus, Hereford & Shorthorn) \$40.00
- 502-2 Commercial Heifer-Continental (Simmental, Limousine, Charolais & Maine) \$40.00
- 502-3 Commercial Heifer-All Other Breeds \$40.00
  
- 600-1 Showmanship/Senior (16 years of age & older) \$10.00
- 600-2 Showmanship/Intermediate (13 to 15 years of age) \$10.00
- 600-3 Showmanship/Junior (9 to 12 years of age) \$10.00
  
- 601-1 Showmanship/Pee Wee (8 years of age & under) \$10.00
- 601-2 Mother's Day Showmanship \$5.00
  - This class will be held on Sunday prior to the Siskiyou County Local Show and is open to any Mother. Please sign up under the actual exhibitor name (not the child).

## SISKIYOU COUNTY LOCAL SHOW

### GENERAL SHOW RULES:

- Exhibitors must be a resident of the 10<sup>th</sup> or 10A District Agricultural Association/Siskiyou County residents.
- Exhibitors must be entered into at least one class (excluding Showmanship and the Fitting Contest) in the Jackpot Show on Saturday.
- Entries must be submitted online through the website [www.sisqfair.com](http://www.sisqfair.com) until 5:00 PM on Thursday, May 9th (see instructions). Entries submitted on site Friday before 9:00 PM will be charged an additional \$20.00 fee and must be paid in cash.
- There will be no local showmanship class.
- Class premiums will be paid to 4<sup>th</sup> place, awarding 1<sup>st</sup> 40%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 25%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20% and 4<sup>th</sup> 15% of the 50% pay out from exhibitors showing in this class (with the exception of the fitting contest).
- All premiums will be mailed by the Friday after Siskiyou County Local Show to the address on the entry form.
