

SISKIYOU GOLDEN FAIR FLOWER GARDEN COMPETITION GUIDELINES AND RULES

Object: To provide clubs and organizations of Siskiyou County an opportunity to display gardening skills and to compete for prize money at the Siskiyou Golden Fair.

Eligibility: Club must be "official" club, a youth membership, adult membership or both. Only amateur clubs accepted. No professionals.

Entry Fee: NONE

Judging Criteria: Garden form, color and plant usage, use of appropriate decorations and overall appearance. Judging will be based on American System.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be given in addition to cash prizes.

Cash Prizes : Large Gardens – 1st \$200, 2nd \$175, 3rd \$150
Small Gardens – 1st \$175, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$125

RULES:

- Entries must be received by March 15, 2018. Entries are awarded gardens on a first come first served basis and returning entrants have first priority for their previous garden.
- Entrants can select from available gardens (see front sheet)
- Club provides all flowers, plants and garden accessories for garden (items to be approved by fair management)
- Club responsible for soil preparation, planting, weeding and monitoring of garden.
- Representatives should notify the office at least 24 hours before the initial work on the garden begins. Office number is 842-2767.
- Club responsible for providing a sign (max 2'X2') for club recognition.
- Garden to be planted between May 15 and June 30. Late planted gardens will not be eligible for prize money.

FAIR WILL PROVIDE:

- Routine watering (after initial planting)
- Notification to club if problem with garden arises

Garden Access: The fairgrounds are open Tuesday through Friday 8:00AM to 4:30PM, except for recognized holidays.
If weekend or after-hours access is needed, please make arrangements with the front office.
